Annual consultation meeting

On November 1, the Regroupement lavallois pour la réussite éducative (RLPRE) held its **Annual General Meeting** and **Consultation Forum**. More than 65 members and partners attended the event, which provided an opportunity for networking, information sharing and reflection on the importance of inter-sector partnerships in supporting student retention and educational success.



During the Consultation Forum, **Michaël Gaudreault**, a teacher and researcher with the ÉCOBES research and transfer center, gave a presentation on territorial factors influencing academic achievement and student retention in Laval.
