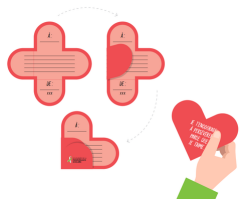


## SUPPORT THE CAMPAIGN

- Use the [campaign visuals](#) in your communications



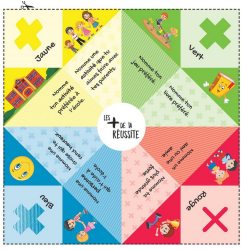
## CELEBRATE EACH EFFORT



- Distribute [stickers](#) to highlight students' hard work or success.
- Ask your students to write messages of encouragement on post-it notes and exchange them with their classmates.
- Applaud the efforts and hard work of a student, a teacher or a parent by giving them a personalized [encouragement card](#)! Your kind words will make a "big difference"!
- Have each child cut and fold the paper into a [heart shaped card](#). Ask them to add a message of gratitude on the back and give the card to an adult who helps them learn and succeed.
- Organize a special ceremony and hand out [certificates of recognition](#) to the students and staff whose efforts and perseverance stand out.

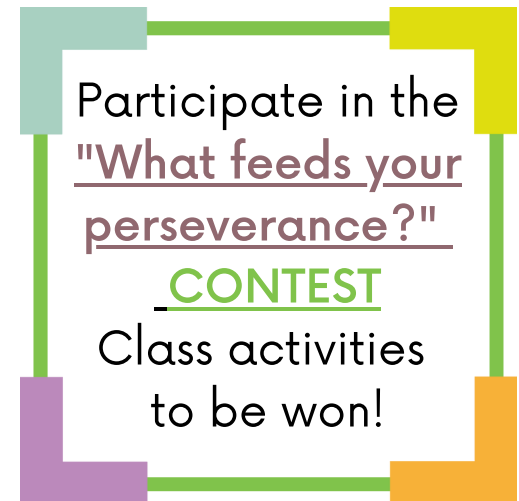


- Plan a green shirt/outfit day!
- Visualization is a powerful motivational tool! Assembling a [vision board](#) is a creative and artistic activity that will help your students dream of their future and add meaning to their perseverance.



- Help the [perseverance tree](#) grow! Draw a tree trunk with branches on the board. Ask each student to write an accomplishment they are proud of on a leaf and invite them to stick it on the tree.

- Prepare and distribute perseverance themed treats with your students (cupcakes with green icing, green smoothies, etc.)
- Ask your students to solve the [crossword puzzle](#). They can work in teams to come up with different words related to perseverance.
